Chinese style base with apple form body and neck

Bronze lid and stand with coil feet by Knud Andersen

Stoneware with oxblood glaze; patinated bronze

Ceramic marked with painted triple wave, Halier cipher, and "1932"

Bronze marked with stamped triple wave and "KA"

Table lamp with Lobed form on a bronzer mount

Modeled after Yongzheng Dynasty Haitangzun (Begonia) vase form

Having a raked wide neck, wide rounded shoulders and tapered sides

Stoneware in a running oxblood glaze

Exotic style bronze stand and mount by Knud Andersen

Painted CH / triple wave marks and date; mount stamped KA mark
